What is a School Board of Governors?

Every school is managed by a Board of Governors that works alongside the school Principal,

with a view to providing the best possible education and educational opportunities for all the pupils, in a secure and safe environment.

A Board of Governors is typically made up of members with different skills, knowledge and experience.

The business of the school is progressed by the whole Board of Governors working together in the best interests of the school children.

A governor is appointed in a voluntary capacity for a four year term of office and can resign at any time.

The Board of Governors meets as often as its business requires which may be once a month depending on the size of the school.

What do school governors do?

The role of the Board of Governors is to make sure that the school provides pupils with a good education.

The Board of Governors sets the plans and policies of the school, employs the school staff and manages the spending of the school budget.


School Website
